

£3,000 in the form of a voucher is available for West Wales Charities, Social Enterprises and businesses. The vouchers are there to cover the costs of installing faster and better broadband. I'm encouraging all West Wales eligible businesses to apply, before the funds run out. The vouchers are issued on a first come, first served basis.
