Implementation of Hire charges for Council owned facilities

Full Council had already agreed that no hire charges would be levied for the current financial year to March 2021.

It was **recommended** that due to the current uncertainty on Covid 19 that the previously agreed fees should be levied for 2021/2022 but that this should be reviewed in the Finance meeting in February 2021.

The fees shown below will be levied for the period 1/4/2021 to 31/3/2022.

Saron Juniors FC - £500 per annum for use of the pitch and facilities at Saron Park.

Llandybie Bowls Club - £3000 per annum for use of the bowling green and a contribution of £500 per annum for use of the pavilion.

Llandybie Tennis Club – £200 per annum and a contribution of £500 per annum for use of the pavilion.

The use of the Multi Use Game Areas at Capel Hendre, Llandybie and Penygroes will remain free of charge for the public to use.
