The Clerk with the assistance of the Administrative Officer went through each application and the amounts recommended were recorded. The exception to the general discussion was the application by Ammanford Fireworks Display which both Cllrs J. Tandy and A. Evans asked that it be noted in the minutes that they felt that noise, chemical pollution and the distress that fireworks cause pets was not something they could approve of. In mitigation both Cllrs A. Jones and C. R. Thomas felt that it was better to contain the celebration in one event than otherwise would encourage wider firework displays and that it was a one-off event annually which offered good revenue opportunities to the local businesses concerned.
