## Projects for 2019-20

a) The Clerk reported that he had received a number of requests for suitable projects during the next financial year. It was agreed to **recommend** to Council that the projects listed below be considered as part of the Community Development programme for 2019-2020.

- 1. Provision of wild flower mats at various locations on roads and in parks
- 2. Provision of pavement to one side of Aberlash Road
- 3. Heart of Wales walking trail notice board
- 4. Plant native trees in parks that are deemed suitable
- 5. Signage on main roads to indicate the presence of the parks
- 6. Signage within each park to highlight ownership
- 7. Sponsorship plaques indicating work done by who and when
- 8. Dog mess / Dogs on lead signage
- 9. Floodlighting at Penygroes park
- 10. Improvements at Llandybie station

b) Projects involving speed humps at the following locations were discussed and it was **recommended** that the Highways department of the County Council be asked for a traffic assessment on all sites.
