Projects for 2018-19

The Technical Officer reported that he had received a number of requests for suitable projects during the next financial year. The projects discussed were :-

- 1. Provision of wild flower mats at various locations
- 2. Siting of Cilyrychen clock within Llandybie village limits
- 3. Improvements at Llandybie station
- 4 .Works to Rights of Way network
- 5 .Provision of pavement to one side of Aberlash Road (part only)
- 6. Provision of speed humps to lower section of Kings Road
- 7. Maintenance of street/footpath lighting
- 8. Maintenance of adopted Parks taken under Asset Transfer
- 9. Provision of Bus Shelter opposite Maes Y Dail estate, Saron
- 10. Relocation of Post Office to Llandybie Memorial Hall
- 11.Llandybie Tennis Courts maintenance and replacement of floodlights
- 12. Changes to Speed Humps at Woodfield Road, Llandybie and Waterloo Road, Penygroes.

Councillor A. Davies also advised the other Members that he had been in discussions with a local group and that this would be brought to Full Council at a later date.

The Technical Officer had only received indicative costings for the provision of the pavement at Aberlash, and the maintenance and upkeep of the parks was still unknown and would be influenced by costings currently being obtained by the Clerk.
