## **Applications for Financial Assistance**

The Clerk distributed detailed copies of the spreadsheet that summarised the applications received from community organisations. A list of application were discussed and the following decisions of note were discussed on applications were awards were not in total agreement and fell short of criteria.

It was felt as a consensus that the Urdd 'Fund for all' appeal application was an all Wales appeal on not of sufficient local focus and therefore was not awarded.

The application from Llandybie Social and Athletic Club it was felt as a consensus was a business and although trustees worked without renumeration it fell outside the volunteer run organisation, charity run, social enterprise and community intertest company stipulation of the award.

The Urdd Eisteddfod Maldwyn 2024 was not awarded in terms of the lack of local focus on where the local precept payers money would be spent.

The Cancer Information and Support Services in South West Wales was not awarded due to the non-local focus of the on where the local precept payers money would be spent.

The application for Y Llofwr was not awarded due to the fact that after repeated request accounts were not forthcoming.

Chair

The award request from Ysgol Llandybie was turned down due to the fact that after repeated requests no acceptable letter from a school extra curriculum pupil .... Was received along with no evidence of where the fund would be deposited.

After much debate the award to Ammanford Netball Club was turned down as members felt there was a lack of Llandybie Community focus on what was an application from a club in the Ammanford Town area.

A special award was made to Penygroes Welfare Hall of £4,000 which was a 50% intervention towards the cost of a new boiler which was key to keeping the hall open as a key community hub for precept paying residents in Penygroes. It was debated and decided that this was in line with a president that been set for special awards to other community halls in the past.

Cllr P. H. Roberts who had declared an interest outlined that Penygroes Welfare Hall had exhausted all other grant avenues but had been successful in the past in attracting 'green grants' for more sustainable energy and energy saving such LED Lighting, new energy efficient windows and Solar Power Panels.

Discussion was had regarding future applications from similar community hubs and it was recognised by members that Llandybie Memorial Hall, Saron Hall, Caerbryn Hall and Penygroes Welfare Hall were examples of key community benefit organisations run by volunteers.

Cllr E. Davies intervened to say that he felt that better 'working together initiative' could be entered into with these identified organisations to realise a forward planning relationship where the need for support within the remit of the grant could identified as an ongoing asset management plan.

It was agreed that the Clerk consider this and include it as an agenda item at the next Ordinary Meeting.

It was agreed that the Clerk include it as an agenda item at the next Ordinary Meeting a formal statement to be adopted by the Council on award criteria to include reference to volunteer run organisation, charity run, social enterprise and community intertest company in the stipulation of the criteria of the grant award. This was to make a clear differentiation between these and a formal 'business' or 'Commercial club or society'.
